Coldest Night of the Year

Back for another year this February!

The Coldest Night of the Year is back Saturday, February 25, 2023. Taking a winter walk in our beautiful city can be enjoyable for some, but for many in our community, the walk to get a warm meal can be deadly without the proper clothing and resources.

The Coldest Night of the Year is a fundraising walk that raises money for those in our community who are experiencing being unhoused. Some of them are hungry, more than a few hurting and regrettably, some who are homeless too. Adults, moms and kids, seniors and youth as well.





Saskatoon currently has reported 550+ people who are living un-housed in our city.

This number only reflects documented cases, and does not take into consideration the population of the hidden-homeless. Oftentimes, the hidden homeless percentage includes high numbers of women as they are less likely to access supports. This can be due to fear, geographical location to services, stigma, gender, age, and more.



This means many are without access to adequate housing. This is even more difficult during the winter months.

Now is the time to join the YWCA as we gather our friends and family together and fundraise for an amazing cause! All funds raised will go directly back to the services, facilities and programming offered at the YWCA Saskatoon.
